The People's Republic of China has received the loan from the Asian Development Bank toward the cost of **JILIN URBAN DEVELOPMENT PROJECT** and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the Contract for Jilin Baicheng City Road network engineering XINHUA XI ROAD with Contract No.: CBC6.
2. The **China Far East International Tendering Company** and **Baicheng Economic Development Zone Development and Investment Co., Ltd.** now invites sealed bids from all eligible and qualified Bidders for **XINHUA XI ROAD** with **Contract no.: CBC6** in Baicheng City, Jilin

Construction period: 18 months

3. **National Competitive Bidding** will be conducted in accordance with ADB's [Single-Stage: One-Envelope](#) bidding procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.
4. 5. The attention of prospective Bidders is drawn to the eligibility and conflict of interest provisions under ITB 4 of the Bidding Documents. All Bidders found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified.
6. Qualifications requirements include:
 - **Historical Financial Performance:**
Submission of audited financial statements or if not required by the law of the bidder's country, other financial statements acceptable to the Employer, for the last THREE [3] years (2013, 2014, 2015) to demonstrate the current soundness of the bidders financial position and its prospective long term profitability. As a minimum, a Bidder's net worth calculated as the difference between total assets and total liabilities for each of the three years should be positive.

- **Average Annual Construction Turnover**

Minimum average annual Construction turnover of CNY112 million calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last THREE (3) years (2013, 2014, 2015).

- **Cash flow Capacity**

The Bidder shall demonstrate access to, or availability of, financial resources such as liquid assets, lines of credit, and other financial means, other than any contractual advance payments to meet: (i) the following cash-flow requirement of CNY11 million and (ii) the overall cash flow requirements for this contract and its concurrent commitments.

- **Contractual Experience**

Bidders should have Experience under contracts in the role of contractor, subcontractor, or management contractor for at least the last FIVE [5] years prior to the bid submission deadline.

Domestic Bidders shall have Grade 2 Certificate of Municipal Construction and Production Safety Certificate issued by the Construction Administrative Agency. Foreign bidders should have equivalent qualification certification from their jurisdictions.

(a) Bidders should have successfully completed at least 2 contracts for Municipal Road construction as the contractor, management contractor or subcontractor during the last FIVE (5) years prior to the bid submission deadline. Each contract amount should not be less than CNY54 million (or equivalent in foreign currency). The similarity shall be based on the physical size, complexity, methods/technology or other characteristics as described in Section VI, Employer's Requirements.

(b) The bidder should demonstrate that these contracts referred to in (a) above or other road infrastructure contracts executed during the period stipulated in (a): include road construction work, communication work, water supply pipeline work and heating networks. A copy of the contract and acceptance certificate should be submitted with the bid.

- **Litigation History**

All pending claims, arbitration or other litigation against the Bidder shall not represent more than 50% of the Bidder's net worth and shall be treated as resolved against the Bidder.

Additional details are provided in the bidding documents.

7. A complete set of bidding documents in Chinese may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the address above and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of CNY1,200 (contains the print edition of commercial part, technical requirements, bill of quantities, and the electronic edition of drawings, initial environmental examination, environmental management plan and the resettlement plan). The method of payment will be remittance or cash. The bidding documents may be sent by Express Mail Service (EMS) for an additional CNY100.

Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person at the address below on **04 May 2017, 9:00 A.M.** All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security as specified in the bidding documents.
