1. The People's Republic of China has received financing from the Asian Development Bank toward the cost of **Guizhou Rocky Desertification Area Water Management Project**. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of the ADB.

2. The **Nayong Pingshan Reservoir Management Office** ("the Employer") invites sealed bids from all eligible Bidders for **Pingshan Reservoir Construction** (the "Works"). The Nayong Pingshan Reservoir is located at Zhongling Town, Nayong County, Bijie Area of Guizhou Province. The dam site is located at the upstream of Gantian River. The height of the foundation surface of the toe plate of bed section is 1594m, the maximum height is 94.00m, the total length of the dam crest is 280m and the width is 10m. The maximum width of the dam is 298.23m. The maximum storage of check flood level is 14.69 million m³ and the normal storage capacity level is 13.71 million m³ with a dead storage capacity of 1.85 million m³, the regulated storage capacity is 11.87 million m³, the reservoir has many-year regulation function.

The main structure comprises: water resource project (Water retaining engineering, Dam foundation accumulation, left dam abutment dangerous rock mass dispose, temporary flood control engineering, upper stream and downstream cofferdam), temporary engineering (construction electricity, construction roads and others), relevant water and soil and environmental protection engineering and others.

Construction period is 40 months from contract signing date.

3. **National Competitive Bidding (NCB)** will be conducted in accordance with ADB's [Single-Stage: One-Envelope](#) procedure and is open to Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.

4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from the Employer or the Procurement Agency (see details below) and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below on working days (8:30-11:30 hours in the morning and 14:00-17:00 hours in the afternoon) except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.

5. The attention of prospective Bidders is drawn to the eligibility and conflict of interest provisions under ITB 4 of the Bidding Documents. All Bidders found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified.

6. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:

- Qualifications: 1st-class qualification as general contractor of Hydraulic and Hydro-Power Engineering, or above level.
- Average Annual Construction Turnover: CNY181,000,000
- Cash-flow requirement: CNY 18,100,000
- Specific Experience: Participation as contractor, in at least two (2) contracts within the last ten (10) years, each with a value of at least CNY 193,000,000

Additional details are provided in the Bidding Documents.

7. A complete set of Bidding Documents in Chinese may be maybe purchased by interested Bidders at the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of CNY 2000 for the whole set of Bidding Documents. The method of payment will be cash or direct deposit (Bank Account Information please see below).

8. Bids must be delivered to the address below **on or before 31 July 2018 at 9:30 hours**. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person at the address below on 31 July 2018 at 9:30 hours. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in the amount as described in the Bidding Document.
