



## Invitation for Bids

1. The Independent State of Samoa has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of **Enhancing Safety, Security and Sustainability of Apia Port**, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this financing to payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
2. The **Samoa Ports Authority** (“the Employer”) invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the **Construction and Completion of the Port Civil Works** (“the Works”).
3. **International Competitive Bidding** will be conducted in accordance with ADB’s [Single-Stage: One-Envelope](#) bidding procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.
4. Only eligible Bidders with following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:
  - Minimum annual construction turnover of USD\$46M for the last three (3) years.
  - Financial resources of USD\$5.75M
  - Demonstrated experience of a similar nature and experience including:
    - Contracts in locations remote from the contractor’s operational base(s) such that logistics management and programming is a significant factor in the project
    - Contracts including substantial marine, port or coastal engineering content and marine operations
    - Manufacture and transport of proprietary precast concrete elements, minimum size of each unit 8 cu.m.
    - Construction of marine breakwater or slope protection in water > 5m in depth at a location exposed to ocean swells and wave action, minimum 10,000 cu.m. of primary armour.
    - Construction, on a single contract, of a minimum of 2,000 sqm of heavy-duty pavement located within an operating transshipment terminal, industrial facility or similar.

More details of qualification requirements are mentioned in the Bidding Documents.

Bid addenda, clarifications etc. will be issued only to those entities that have obtained the Bidding Documents from the official source or through Tenderlink and formally registered their interest.

6. Bids must be submitted through Tenderlink **on or before the deadline: 15 June 2020; 11:00 hours (Local Time)** together with a Bid Security as described in Section 2 of the Bidding Document.
7. Bids will be opened immediately after the deadline for bid submission in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend.
