The Government of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of **Greater Colombo Water and Wastewater Management Improvement Investment Program – Tranche 2**. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contract named above. This contract will be jointly financed by Agency Francaise de Development (AFD). The eligibility rules and procedures of ADB will govern the bidding process.

2. The **Chairman, Project Procurement Committee-Major (PPC-Major), on behalf of the National Water Supply and Drainage Board** now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the **Procurement of Machinery and Equipment for Operation and Maintenance Activities of Western Production Section**. Bidders may bid for one, combination, or all of the lots.

3. **International Competitive Bidding** will be conducted in accordance with ADB's [Single-Stage: One-Envelope](#) bidding procedure and is open to all bidders from eligible countries as described in the bidding document.

4. To be eligible and qualified for contract award, the successful bidder shall fulfil the qualification requirements as detailed in the bidding document.
