

## Invitation for Bids

1. The Republic of Tajikistan has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of **National Disaster Risk Management Project**, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this financing to payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
2. The **Committee of Emergency Situations and Civil Defense of the Republic of Tajikistan (CESCD)** (“the Purchaser”) invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for **Supply, Installation and Commissioning of Equipment for Sarez Lake Monitoring and Early Warning Systems**. The system, that will be procured, will enable real time and reliable monitoring of Sarez Lake, right and left banks of the lake and downstream river for data gathering, early warning system activation and communications with required units.
3. **Open Competitive Bidding – International** will be conducted in accordance with ADB’s [Single-Stage: One-Envelope](#) bidding procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.
4. Only eligible Bidders with following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:
  - Successful completion as main supplier within the last three (3) years, of at least two (2) contracts each valued at USD 600,000 with nature, and complexity similar to the scope of supply,
  - The Bidder must demonstrate that the goods offered have (i) been in production for at least three (3) years, (ii) been sold a minimum of two (2) units of similar type and specification over the last three (3) years; and (iii) been in operation for a minimum of three (3) years,
  - The Bidder must demonstrate soundness of its financial position. As a minimum, the Bidder’s net worth for the last year calculated as the difference between total assets and total liabilities should be positive,
  - The Bidder must have a minimum average annual turnover of USD 1,500,000 calculated as total payments received by the Bidder for contracts completed or under execution over the last three (3) years,
  - The Bidder must demonstrate availability of or access to liquid assets, lines of credit, and other finances sufficient to meet cash flow requirement which is USD 700,000.

This document summarizes only a part of the requirements for information to the potential Bidders. Bidders are requested to refer to the Bidding Document for the full range of criteria prior to submitting a bid. If there are any discrepancies between this Invitation for Bid and the Bidding Document, the Bidding Document shall prevail.
