1. The Republic of Uzbekistan has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of **Integrated Urban Development Project**. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the Contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.

2. The **Ministry of Investments and Foreign Trade (MIFT) Project Implementation Unit (PIU)** (“the Employer”) invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the **Modernizing and Operational Efficiency Improvements in Djizzak City Water Supply** (“the Works”).

3. **Open competitive bidding (international advertisement)** will be conducted in accordance with ADB’s [Single-Stage: One Envelope](#) bidding procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.

4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:

- Minimum average annual construction turnover of USD 11.7 million calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last three (3) years (2020-2022, starting from January 1, 2020).
- Participation in at least one (1) contract that has been successfully or substantially completed within the last five (5) years and that is similar to the proposed works, where the value of the Bidder’s participation exceeds USD 6.25 million. The similarity of the Bidder’s participation shall be based on the physical size, nature of works, complexity, methods, technology or other characteristics (e.g., water supply pipelines and equipment) as described in Section 6 (Employer’s Requirements).
- Experience in the following key activities:
 - Construction of not less than 5 wells, each with the installation of borehole pumps not less than Q = 100m³ / hour
 - Construction of water networks of non-metallic pipes with diameter 500 and more, with a total length of not less than 20 km completed in 12 months
 - Electrical installation and installation of 5 pcs bactericidal installations at water intakes.

The qualification criteria are more completely described in the Bidding Document.
