1. The **Socialist Republic of Vietnam** has received financing from the Asian Development Bank toward the cost of the **Low Carbon Agricultural Support Project (LCASP)**, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.

2. The **Central Project Management Unit (CPMU) of the LCASP** invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the **supply of manure separating system to treat livestock waste to produce material for organic fertilizer demonstration for Ha Tinh, Nam Dinh, Soc Trang, Son La, and Tien Giang provinces**. The contract consists of five (5) lots. Bidders can bid for any single lot or any combination of lots, as follows:

- Lot 1: Ha Tinh.
- Lot 2: Nam Dinh.
- Lot 3: Soc Trang.
- Lot 4: Son La.
- Lot 5: Tien Giang

3. **National Competitive Bidding (NCB)** will be conducted in accordance with ADB's [Single-Stage: One-Envelope](#) procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.

4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:
- Average annual turnover defined as the total payments received by the Bidder for contracts completed or under execution over the last three (3) years of: **Lot 1: Ha Tinh: VND 4.6 billion; Lot 2: Nam Dinh: VND 12.8 billion; Lot 3: Soc Trang: VND 2.9 billion; Lot 4: Son La: VND 9.6 billion; Lot 5: Tien Giang: VND 10 billion.**
 - The Bidder must demonstrate access to, or availability of, liquid assets, lines of credit, or other financial resources, net of current commitments to meet the financial resources requirement of **Lot 1 is VND 692 million, Lot 2 is VND 1.92 billion, Lot 3 is VND 444 million; Lot 4 is VND 1.44 billion; Lot 5 is VND 1.50 billion** for the subject contract.

- Participation in at least two (2) contracts that have been successfully completed within the last three (3) years, and that are similar to the proposed goods, where the value of the Bidder's participation exceeds: **Lot 1: Ha Tinh: VND 1.84 billion; Lot 2: Nam Dinh: VND 5.12 billion; Lot 3: Soc Trang: VND 1.18 billion; Lot 4: Son La: VND 3.84 billion; Lot 5: Tien Giang: VND 4.00 billion.**

The qualification criteria are more completely described in the Bidding Document.

5. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from Mr. Nguyen, The Hinh, Director of Central Project Management Unit of LCASP and inspect the Bidding Documents during office hours (Monday to Friday, from 8:00 to 17:00 hours) at the address given below.

6. A complete set of Bidding Documents in Vietnamese may be purchased by interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of VND 2,000,000 (two million Vietnamese dong). The method of payment will be in cash or bank transferring (Bank account: 1507201061135 at Agribank – Cau Giay branch, please state clearly content of transferring: payment for Bidding Document of Package 33). The document may be sent through a courier for an additional cost of VND 50,000. No liability will be accepted for loss or late delivery.

7. Bids must be delivered to the address below **on or before 9:00 hours, 26 August 2017.** Together with a Bid Security as described in the Bidding Document. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened immediately in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below at **9:00 hours on 26 August 2017.**
