1. The Government of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (hereinafter called "ADB") toward the cost of **Second Greater Mekong Subregion (GMS) Corridor Towns Development Project**. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contract package named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.

2. The **Lao Cai Provincial ODA Projects Management Unit** ("the Employer") invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the construction and completion of package **SP1: SaPa: Wastewater and Drainage**, which consists of the following:

- Drainage system: 16,000 m
- Two (2) waste water treatment plants with the capacity of 5000 m³/day and 2500 m³/day accordingly in a mountainous area.

3. **International Competitive Bidding (ICB)** will be conducted in accordance with ADB's [Single-Stage: One-Envelope](#) procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.

4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:

- Participation in at least one (1) contract that has been successfully or substantially completed within the last five (5) years and that is similar to the proposed works, where the value of the Bidder's participation exceeds USD 8.76 million. The similarity of the Bidder's participation shall be based on the physical size, nature of works, complexity, methods, technology or other characteristics as described in Section 6, Employer's Requirements.

- Minimum average annual construction turnover of USD 8.76 million calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last three (3) years.
- Minimum financial resources of USD 1.09 million.

The qualification criteria are more completely described in the Bidding Document.

- Alternatively, the Bidding Document may be sent by courier upon the Bidder's written request and upon payment of an additional amount of maximum US\$ 300 depending on delivery location for overseas delivery or VND 500,000 for delivery in Vietnam. The Employer will assume no liability for loss or late delivery.

- Together with a Bid Security as described in the Bidding Document.

Late bids shall be rejected. Bids will be opened immediately after the bid submission deadline at the above-mentioned address in the presence of Bidders' representatives who wish to attend.
