1. The Socialist Republic of Viet Nam has received a loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of the **Greater Mekong Subregion Health Security Project** and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
2. The **Ministry of Health, General Department of Preventive Medicine through the Greater Mekong Subregion Health Security Project** (“the Purchaser”) invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the supply of:

Lot 1: Residual sprayers and ULV sprayers

- 482 sets of Hand sprayers (net weight ≤ 5kg)
- 468 sets of ULV Spraying Machine (dry weight from 10 kg to 12 kg).

Lot 2: Entomological kits, sampling and transportation kit, and handheld thermometer

- 454 sets of Insect Investigation Kit
- 472 sets of Sample collection, preservation and transportation of specimens
- 879 sets of Handheld temperature gauge

Lot 3: Microscopes and magnifying glasses

- 369 sets of Microscopes with 2 eyes (Microscope with 3 optical channels)
- 481 Dissecting magnifying glasses (Stereo microscopes).

Delivery of Goods will be to the project locations specified in Section VII of the Bidding Document within 180 days of the date of contract signing. Bidders may submit bids for one or more lots.

3. **National Competitive Bidding** will be conducted in accordance with ADB’s Single-Stage: One-Envelope procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible source countries as described in the Bidding Document.
4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding (Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence that it meets the experience and financial

requirements, which include):

- that the Bidder has successfully completed at least one (1) contract within the last five (5) years (2014-2018) for Goods similar to those proposed (medical or scientific equipment) with a value not less than
 - VND18 Billion (for Lot 1),
 - VND 6 Billion (for Lot 2) and
 - VND 26 Billion (for Lot 3).

In the event the Bidder bids for more than one (1) lot, the Bidder must provide at least one contract for similar goods with a value not less than the sum of the required contract values of each individual lot, or separate individual contracts meeting the requirement for each lot.

- that the Bidder has a minimum average annual turnover of:
 - VND 36 Billion (for Lot 1),
 - VND 12 Billion (for Lot 2) and
 - VND 52 Billion (for Lot 3)

calculated as total payments received by the Bidder for contracts completed or under execution over the last three (3) years:

- that the Bidder has availability of or access to liquid assets, lines of credit, and other finances sufficient to meet cash flow requirement which is:
 - VND 7.1 Billion (for Lot 1),
 - VND 2.3 Billion (for Lot 2) and
 - VND 10.4 Billion (for Lot 3)
- that, in the case of a Bidder not doing business within Viet Nam, the Bidder is, or will be (if awarded the contract), represented by an Agent in Viet Nam equipped and able to carry out the Supplier's warranty, maintenance, repair, and spare parts stocking obligations prescribed in the Conditions of Contract and/or Technical Specifications.

The qualification criteria are more completely described in the Bidding Document.
